**DEPOSIT** - A non-refundable deposit of \$50 per person or \$100 per family must accompany your registration. This may be paid with check made payable to Northern Pines or online with credit card at [npines.org/pay](http://npines.org/pay)

**PAYMENT POLICY** - Unless otherwise arranged with the registrar, payments are due as follows: 50% due February 1<sup>st</sup>; Final Payment due May 1<sup>st</sup>. If registration occurs after February 1<sup>st</sup>, 50% payment is due immediately and full payment is due by May 1<sup>st</sup> or as arranged with the registrar. **LATE FEES** - Any payments made after June 1<sup>st</sup> (unless otherwise arranged with the registrar) will incur a \$40 late fee.
